2007 Legislative Session Update from Tallahassee

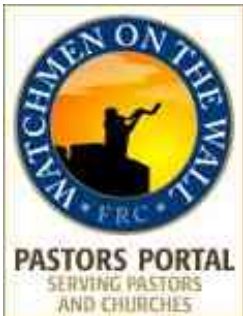

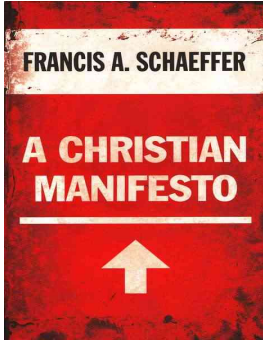
