



Pastor:

Deliver a FREE pre-recorded phone message to all your church members reminding them to vote

3 STEPS TO CREATING A PERSONALIZED MESSAGE FROM YOU

STEP 1: Create the script for the recorded phone message using our sample message on the back of this document as a guide. *The recorded message should be under 60 seconds.*

STEP 2: Call into the CCS Automated Recording Line to record the message.

Call **213-204-6776** (use of a land-line phone is preferred for better sound quality).

Enter PIN **5719991757#** when prompted.

Follow the voice prompt instructions for recording the script.

Follow the voice prompt instructions for listening to, re-recording or saving the recorded message.

Hang up when finished. All recordings will then drop into the CCS voice file processing que for final review and project set up.

STEP 3: Email a list of your church member's phone numbers (in Excel or CSV file format) to: Jon Domeij, President of Creative Communication Strategies - jdomeij@ccstrategies.net

Be sure to include in the Body of the email your:

- A. Church Name
- B. Church Address
- C. Key Contact Direct Phone Number (in case there are questions)
- D. Pastor's Full Name who will be recording the message
- E. Church Phone Number (To Appear in Caller ID - **REQUIRED**)

SAMPLE PHONE SCRIPT FOR PASTORS

“Hello, this is Pastor (insert your name) with (church name).

I’m calling to give you a friendly reminder that the Presidential election is coming soon on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

And because this election is so very important, I want to encourage you to start planning now on how you are going to vote.

There are several options:

You can request an absentee ballot from the County Supervisor of Elections...

You can early vote in many locations – OR –

You can vote in person on election day.
