Florida Leaders' Summit on Protecting Children from Transgender Ideology





2021 Legislative Session Victories: Parents' Rights Bill & Save Women's Sports Bill



Two major victories. 
Evening with Dennis Prager

 Responding to Critical Race Theory and Transgender Ideology, Co-sponsored by the Heritage Foundation




